# Call for participants

“The Future We Want” is a 9-months-project on campaigning and advocacy for the Agenda2030.

It consists of:

- an **online learning module** (Jan. 15 to Apr. 15, 2024, approx. 2h/week)
- a **training course in Busteni, Romania** (Apr. 19-28, 2024)
- individual and group **preparation** work (May-Aug., 2024, approx. 2h/week)
- a **transnational caravan** through 17 European cities plus an **online campaign** (Aug. 27 to Sep. 16, 2024)

The **project's aim** is to increase young European's level of **engagement with sustainability and development** and to provide a **meaningful voice to European youth** in setting the EU policy agenda on the **SDG** on a local and European level.

# Call for participants

What you need to know:

- To apply, you must be sure to **be able to participate in the full project**, esp. during the training course and the caravan. You will sign a **volunteering contract** on the conditions of involvement, duties and responsibilities.
- After participation, you will receive a **certificate**.
- Accomodation (in shared rooms) and 3 vegetarian/vegan meals per day will be provided for the training course and the caravan.
- Travel expenses to the training course and back as well as to the starting point of the caravan and back are covered, as well as travel insurance.
- You will also receive 400 € to cover personal expenses during the caravan.
